# ***Frequently Asked Questions***

## **1. Why are Internationals 2019 and LIFE 2019 being hosted together?**

Both the International Quizzing finals and the LIFE conference are significant events on the youth ministry calendar of the Christian & Missionary Alliance. Both events bring youth together from across North America to worship, be challenged and encourage one another. LIFE is a life-changing experience for many youth and we wanted our quizzing community to have an opportunity to be part of it. Hosting our championship final quizzes at the LIFE conference also gives LIFE attendees an opportunity to see and experience quizzing, perhaps for the first time. ## **2. How will the Internationals 2019 schedule differ from previous years?**

The first three days of Internationals (July 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>) will follow the typical International quizzing schedule. Quizzing teams will arrive during the afternoon of Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup> at Johnson University, 1011 Bill Beck Blvd., Kissimmee, FL 34744. All preliminary quizzing will take place on July 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. The XYZ quizzes will be held during the evening of July 7<sup>th</sup>.

July 8<sup>th</sup> will be a free day for teams to enjoy the various activities in the Orlando area (Disney, Universal, Fun Spot, Aquatica, SeaWorld, The Holy Land Experience). Breakfast will be served at Johnson University, but teams are responsible for their other meals that day. Discounted theme park rates are available: <https://ttt.hello-dmc.com/cf/life19/index.asp>

The semi-final and consolation bracket quizzing will take place during the morning and afternoon of July 9<sup>th</sup>. In the late afternoon, quizzing teams will leave Johnson University and travel to the Orlando World Center Marriott, 8701 World Center Dr, Orlando, FL 32821. The two venues are located approximately 12 miles apart.

Once quizzing teams arrive at LIFE 2019, they will join the other LIFE attendees for conference activities throughout the evening of July 9<sup>th</sup> and the morning of July 10<sup>th</sup>. Quizzing teams will not participate in the LIFE service projects on July 10<sup>th</sup> but are encouraged to attend the seminars or enjoy the activity hall during the early afternoon. The Consolation and Championship Finals will be held in the late afternoon with the awards ceremony immediately to follow. Quizzing teams will then rejoin LIFE attendees for dinner and the evening activities on July 10<sup>th</sup>.

Quizzing teams will depart on July 11<sup>th</sup>. Check out time is 10 a.m.

## **3. What transportation options will be available?**

Quizzing teams are responsible for their own transportation to and from the various venues (Johnson University, Orlando's theme parks, LIFE at the Orlando World Center Marriott, and the airport).

#### **4. Can teams “opt-out” of attending the LIFE portion of the event?**

The registration fee and schedule for Internationals 2019 includes July 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> at LIFE 2019 for quizzers and coaches (including the Championship Finals and awards ceremony on July 10<sup>th</sup>). Quizzers and coaches will receive a wristband that will allow them to access meals and activities on July 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. While we are still finalizing the registration fee, we estimate it will be around \$475 USD for the full Internationals 2019 event.

#### **5. Will there be an additional cost for parents or guests who also want to attend LIFE programming on July 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>?**

Parents or guests who would like to participate in the LIFE activities while staying off-site will be charged an additional fee. Those who wish to attend only the Finals and Awards Ceremony on July 10<sup>th</sup> will be charged the normal International finals spectator fee. We are working on finalizing the amounts of these additional fees.

#### **6. How should I register if I am planning to attend LIFE 2019 with my youth group?**

Quizzers or coaches who are planning to attend LIFE 2019 with their youth group should follow the normal LIFE registration process to ensure they are registered for the full conference. When you register for Internationals 2019, we will adjust your registration fee to reflect the fact that you have already registered for LIFE.

#### **7. How will logistics such as meals, parking, etc. be handled at LIFE 2019?**

Please see the LIFE 2019 website (see link above) for these logistical details. Parents or guests who are not registered for Internationals 2019 will be responsible for their own meals. Individual meals can be purchased at Johnson University and several restaurants are located at the World Center Marriott. There are no off-site restaurants within walking distance of the World Center Marriott.

#### **8. Will there be an “all-nighter” this year?**

Unfortunately, no. Once quizzers and coaches arrive at LIFE 2019 on July 9<sup>th</sup>, we must respect the same schedule as the rest of the attendees. This includes a “Lights Out” time of 11:30 p.m. Plus, we will be having so much fun during the day that we will be collapsing with exhaustion by then!
